



Red Lodge Fire Rescue Foundation Scholarship

Due May 1, 2020

The Red Lodge Fire Rescue Foundation (the “Foundation”) is pleased to offer a scholarship to qualified members of Red Lodge High School’s graduating class. The scholarship will be awarded to pay tuition, books and/or room and board at the university, college (2 or 4 year), community college or trade or technical school at which the recipient is enrolled following high school graduation. The scholarship will be paid directly to the recipient’s university, college, community college or trade or technical school upon confirmation of the recipient’s enrollment.

A qualified applicant for the Foundation’s scholarship will satisfy the following requirements:

1. As of the date of graduation, at least one parent/guardian of the applicant shall be a member in good standing of the Red Lodge Fire Rescue and shall have been a member in good standing for a period of not less than three years, or the applicant shall intend to pursue a career as a Firefighter, EMT or Paramedic.
2. The applicant shall graduate from Red Lodge High School with the spring graduating class.
3. The applicant shall enroll at a university, college (2 or 4 year), community college or trade or technical school no later than the fall semester (or equivalent) following high school graduation.
4. The applicant shall not have received and accepted a scholarship to any university, college (2 or 4 year), community college or trade or technical school which will pay for the entire costs of the applicant’s tuition, books and room and board for the fall semester.
5. The applicant shall not have been convicted of possession, use or sale of alcohol or any other drug (including any conviction for driving while impaired), violence against any other person or sexual misconduct, or any felony.
6. The applicant shall have completed an application and delivered the application to the Foundation not later than May 1, 2020.

The Foundation will select and announce the recipient of its scholarships on or before the date of graduation. The Foundation reserves the right to withdraw the scholarship award if the recipient does not satisfy one or more of the qualifications or has provided incorrect information on his/her application.
